Festivities kick off in early September with a virtual vendor village, weekly activities and contests and culminate with a celebratory live Walk broadcast from the shelter on Sunday, October 18.

The Heart & Sole Walk is our largest fall fundraiser and our goal is to raise \$90,000 through peer-to-peer donations and sponsorships.
